Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

With this season of COVID in our lives, here in the US and around the world, it is very difficult to write words of comfort. It is heart-rending, especially to those families that have lost loved ones without being able to say goodbye. The news each day gives us a grim picture of the loss of lives, jobs, business, the closing of schools, isolation, and the effects on the elderly. And it looks like the worst is not over.

As Thanksgiving approaches and we evaluate whether to gather with our loved ones, the unknowns of this pandemic are painful. And yet, while we do not understand God’s ways, He is calling us to pray and to seek Him. *“Call to me and I will answer, and I will tell you great and mighty things, which You do not know”* (Jeremiah 33:3). It was a blessing when Franklin Graham called for a day of prayer. Let us continue to pray that Father God will heal our land.

The Board and I want to thank you from the depth of our hearts for your prayers and sacrificial support of the Food Basket Program. We serve 72 baskets each week to families, most of which have no other means of daily food. We prioritize the elderly with no income except their government pensions, which in Guyana is nominal, or to single parents who are not employed. Recently, Father God allowed a monetary gift toward the Food Basket. With this monetary gift, and our current funding, the Food Basket program will run out of funds in early April, 2021.

GO is seeking the Lord’s guidance to start a pilot program to donate seeds or start a nursery of vegetables and fruits. The idea is that if the Food Basket families can start a small garden in their backyards, they can help themselves by providing some food year-round. We are working out the logistics, such as providing mesh to keep animals out and guidance in gardening. If you have gardening experience and would like to help provide guidance on watering, fertilizing, and the like, we would love to hear from you.

Because of COVID, the schools in Guyana are closed until January of 2021. We are in the planning stages of the curriculum, new staff, and serving the community. However, GO has maintained a part-time staff for the Food Basket program and building maintenance.

GO has been praying and seeking a missionary to Guyana for quite some time now. We are blessed that the Rev. Wondimu Game is communicating with the Rev. Dr. James Tino, Global Lutheran Outreach
