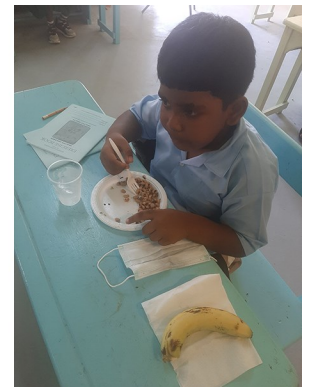

The Board and I give thanks to Father God that through your loving and sacrificial financial support, the Food Basket Program was a blessing and fed many poor families.

Each basket contained approximately \$17.00 of groceries. Single parent families stretched those groceries to last 2 weeks. It was heartbreaking to close the program as we ran out of funds but we are thankful to the good Lord that we delivered 3,178 baskets. All of your donations went directly to purchase food. None was used for any administrative costs or salaries. Father God promises many blessings to you in return. It has been truly a blessing and joy as we labored together to feed the poorest of the poor.

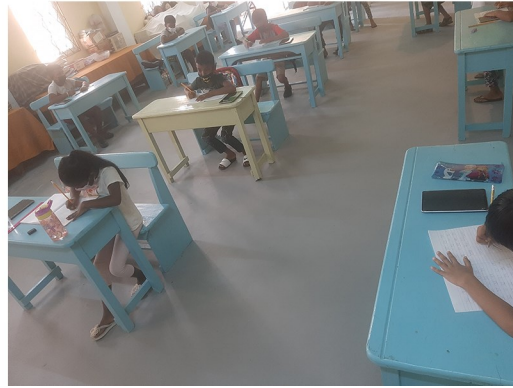
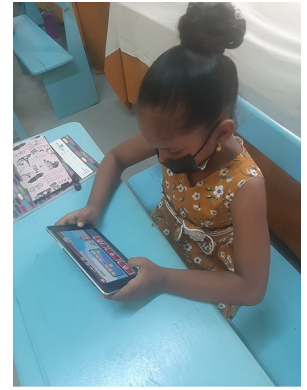


Because of COVID, all schools were closed since March 2020. The government has recently reopened primary schools and in turn, GO has resumed our Functional Literacy and Math after school program for first, second and third grades. GO adheres to all COVID guidelines. Children sit six feet apart with masks. We also distribute daily snacks.

Please join us in prayers for Victor and Belén Revas from Guatemala. They are now raising funds to be GO’s missionaries in Guyana under the guidance of Rev. Dr. James Tino, Director Global Lutheran Outreach (GLO), Santiago Chile. “You will be pleased to know that Victor and Belén have initiated their “support discovery” process in Guatemala and are working diligently at it. They need to identify 60% of their first year’s financial needs before they are eligible for deployment under GLO.”

The Board and I are asking that we pray for many blessings for GLO and Victor and Belen as they raise their funding. GLO also supports missionaries around the world as our Lord has commanded, *“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit”* (Matthew 28:19). *“The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few”* (Matthew 9:37).
